STAFF GUIDED WORKSHOPS

Exploratory Services: Everyone doing a job search should complete *WorkSource* registration. *The Exploratory Services* is offered daily except for holidays, and inclement weather closures, and may take up to 90 minutes to complete. Attendees must arrive in time to complete the process. See *Front Desk* for more information.

BankWork\$ Information Session: The BankWork\$ Information Session provides an overview of the BankWork\$ program offered at SE Works, as well as eligibility requirements and the application process.

Career Exploration: This workshop enables you to develop a career goal by exploring your skills, aptitudes, and experience and then, match them to current industry and occupational trends.

Career Networking Job Club: This energizing workshop provides you with tips and tools to improve job search techniques. It also offers an opportunity to network with other job seekers and share job leads. Participants will complete an employment plan and set goals linked to gaining employment.

Career Boost Info Session: The Career Boost Information Session provides details about training resources available to SNAP recipients.

Drop-in Advising: Visit an advisor during drop-in hours for quick questions regarding training, employment, or supportive services.

Drop-in Job Search Assistance: Participants receive assistance with their job search (e.g. review of resumes, cover letters, applications, etc.) in a lab setting. Please ask staff for more information and to be referred.

Drop-in Resume Assistance: Participants receive 1 on 1 assistance with their resumes. Please attend the Resume Workshop prior to this session.

Discover Your Road to Success: Tired of hearing "no" from employers due to your criminal background? In this on-going workshop you will learn how to discuss your background with employers and address other skills needed to obtain employment in a changing and challenging job market.

ELL Rosetta Stone/Open Skills Lab: Language software instruction to learn English for ELL students. All levels of English Language Learners (ELL) welcome.

Interpersonal skills workshop: In this workshop you will learn to recognize your own interpersonal skills as well as areas you may need to improve. You will learn to communicate examples of your interpersonal skills during a job interview so that employers can recognize YOU as the top candidate for their company.

Interview Workshop: Making a professional impression during an interview is essential to getting hired. This workshop reviews interview basics and teaches you how to handle interview questions.

Job Search Strategies Workshop: Learn strategies to increase your job search effectiveness. This workshop includes pointers on how you can use iMatchskills® and other online resources as part of your efforts.

Health Careers NW Information Session: Learn about the Health Careers NW grant, which provides training, education, and job search to eligible individuals for high-demand careers in healthcare. Information will be given about program eligibility, enrollment procedures, and grant details.

Health Careers NW for Professional Immigrants: Same focus of the Health Careers NW grant, but for the Professional Immigrant living within the city of Portland boundaries (geographic restrictions to be discussed).

National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC): A nationally recognized certificate, the NCRC assesses work-related skills in three areas: math, reading, and locating information. Please ask staff for more information. **(Required preschedule at least 24 hours ahead)**

Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Enrollement Workshop: Work one-on-one with a Certified Assistor to enroll for healthcare coverage through the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange.

PREP (Prisoner Re-entry Employment Program) Information Session: Attend this information session to learn about the PREP program designed to assist individuals with a background and barriers to employment. Registration after Session. **(THIS WORKSHOP CURRENTLY IS NOT BEING OFFERED)**

Preparing for the Graphic Literacy Assessment: This workshop will expose you to the types of questions that will be on Graphic Literacy Assessment to ultimately help you improve your scores.

Resume Workshop: In this workshop, job seekers will learn strategies and formats for resumes to help you make decisions about how to present your accomplishments in the most compelling way.

Reboot Information Session: Learn information about training opportunities funded through Reboot grant. Targeted Industries are: Information Technology, Software, Hi-Tech Manufacturing, Industrial Manufacturing. Information on grant details, eligibility, and the application process.

Resume for Job Seekers with a Background: A resume workshop for job seekers reentering the community after incarceration. This workshop provides an overview of how to write a resume, an overview of a cover letter, and hands-on experience on the computer.

Rethinking Job Search Info Session: Learn about Rethinking workshop series to address the social and emotional consequences of unemployment to help job seekers find work faster! Assistance provided with Signing up for workshop after Info Session.

Rethinking Job Search: A series of 12 workshops that helps job seekers reestablish their confidence, motivation, and accountability while continuing to look for their next job. This workshop is intended for job seekers currently receiving Oregon Unemployment Insurance benefits.

TechRise PDX Information Session: Learn information about career pathways in Hardware Support or Software Developer through this grant. Details of the program, application process, and eligibility will be discussed.

WSPM Scholarship Application: Learn how to apply, plan, and help pay for occupational training utilizing WorkSource training funds. Scholarship are limited and not every application is approved.

Workplace MS Computer Basics: After completing this course, job seekers will be able to identify the main parts of a computer, learn basic Windows commands and access the Windows programs. Job seekers will be able to navigate the Internet, send and receive emails, and save documents on the computer and on the web.

Workplace Microsoft Office: Learn how to use MS Word to create a professional resume layout from scratch, how to use MS Excel spreadsheets and formulas to create a basic checkbook, and how to create a PowerPoint presentation.

Youth Career Connections Information Session: This information session will give you an introduction to the State of Oregon funded **Youth Career Connections** program, WorkSource products and services and cost free occupational skills training. This information session may lead to enrollment in the Youth Career Connections program and / or youth attaching to WorkSource services identified in the Information Session.

Youth Career Connections is a program open to eligible youth 18-24 who are interested in securing employment, cost free occupational skills training and certifications, referral to youth GED services, support services, case management and follow up to ensure support & success.
